All applications to the First Year Group/Special Classes for all year groups in Carrigtwohill Community College will only be accepted after 01 October 2024. The closing date for all applications to the First Year Group/Special Classes for all year groups in Carrigtwohill Community College will be 22 October 2024. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.

All transfer applications to the Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth or Sixth Year Groups in Carrigtwohill Community College, other than to the Special Classes, will only be accepted after the 01 March 2025 and the closing date for receipt of transfer applications is 01 April 2025. Applications received after this date will be considered and processed as late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy. Please be reminded that, in line with the school's Admission Policy and the Education (Admission to Schools) Act 2018, all waiting lists going forward are only in place for the academic year to which they apply. Therefore, if a student is seeking a place in the Special Class and is not successful in a given academic year or is on a waiting list for this year, a new application must be made for the following year.

All applicants to the First-Year Group/Special Class will be notified of an offer of a place or refusal of admission by:	12 November 2024
Successful applicants to the First Year Group/Special Class must confirm their acceptance of an offer of admission to Carrigtwohill Community College by completing and returning the Acceptance Form on or before:	26 November 2024
Note: Failure to accept an offer of admission before the relevant deadline set out above may result in the offer being withdrawn.	

Carrigtwohill Community College will cooperate with the National Council for Special Education in the performance by the Council of its functions under the Education for Persons with Special Educational Needs Act 2004 relating to the provision of education to children with special educational needs, including in particular by the provision and operation of a special class or classes when requested to do so by the Council.
